

Garden of Remembrance Live Streaming Platform

As a courtesy to bereaved families, especially during the Covid pandemic when attendance at funerals can be affected, the Garden of Remembrance provides a livestream video link to graveside and memorial chapel services.

We use the StreamSpot livestream platform, which is accessible from our website homepage, does not require a password, can accommodate up to 200 viewers, and is generally secure against hacking and interruption. Families wishing to livestream a burial service or unveiling, must request this option in advance. Families arranging a livestream should tell family and friends to go to the Livestream link found on the righthand side of our website homepage (gardenofremembrance.org) at the scheduled time of the funeral or unveiling.....

Through StreamSpot, services and unveilings are archived in the StreamSpot cloud for approximately 60 days and a link to download and save the recording can be accessed by families upon request. The Garden of Remembrance does not keep a permanent copy of the recording. StreamSpot does not provide two-way communications with online participants.

We are happy to provide this technology to our families, but please understand that we are not professional videographers and cannot control connection strength, recording quality, wind conditions, weather-related tablet malfunctions, volume of speakers, or other factors that may affect the audio or visual quality of a livestreamed and recorded memorial service. Our graveside equipment can fail during extreme heat or cold conditions. If a livestream or recording of high quality is important to you, many Funeral Homes offer professional audio-visual services to their families or can direct you to an independent professional.
